Former Muslim EXPOSES Islam After READING the Quran for Herself @Daily Dose Of Wisdom

BRANDON: This woman is on a mission she's not a Muslim and her Muslim dress is a disguise her mission is for Muslims to know what is in the Quran because she says if more Muslims knew what was in the Quran more would leave Islam all right folks welcome back to the channel this video is not an easy topic to address but the more I have looked into this the more that I'm convinced that I need to address it it features a story of a woman who is raised as a Muslim but then left Islam after reading the Quran her s I'll pause just a few times to either add a little bit of context or to quote the Quran directly let's dive in Mona Walter came to Sweden from Somalia as a war Refugee when she was 19 she says she was excited about joining a modern European nation with equal rights for women but as a young Muslim woman that was not the Sweden she encountered in fact she says it was in Sweden where she first experienced radical Islam on a daily basis.

MONA WALTER: I discover Islam here in Sweden in Somalia you're not you're just a Muslim you're just born into Muslim country without knowing the Quran but when you come to Sweden then you go to mosque and there's a Quran so you have to cover yourself you have to be a good Muslim.

BRANDON: Walter says she grew up in Somalia never having read the Quan MONA WALTER: so I didn't understand what I was part of I didn't know who Muhammad was I didn't know who Allah was so when I found out I was I was upset I was sad and I was disappointed

BRANDON: she says she discovered that Allah is a God who hates and that Islam is not a religion of Peace

MONA WALTER: it's about um hating and killing those who disagree with Islam is about conquering Muhammad he was say immoral he was a bloodthirsty man he was terrible man and they can read that in his biography what he did to Jews how he raped women how he killed people I mean he killed everyone who didn't agree with him discouraged she left Islam and became an atheist until one day a family relative encouraged her to read the Bible.

BRANDON: she still remembers the first time she read Matthew 5:44 where Jesus said to love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you

MONA WALTER: it was very strange for me love your enemy because in Islam you have to kill your enemy kill your enemy and kill everyone who refus Islam but Jesus Christ it was it was all about love and peace and forgiveness and tolerance and for some reason I needed that.

BRANDON: She went to see Pastor foud rashio a Syrian immigrant who ministers to former Muslims in Sweden she started to believe and she came to me from that was a beginning of her her trusting

MONA WALTER: I - I was so happy I I was I was filled with with joy then I accepted Jesus Christ. BRANDON: Mona says the Lord gave her a burden for Muslims who still do not know the truth about Islam and she began to copy verses from the Quran and hand them out on the street to Muslim women.

MONA WALTER: sometime they listen some sometimes they become a very upset and I just uh told that you know that your husband he have a right to beat you if you don't obey him and say no it does not say that yes it says that

BRANDON: okay so the verse that she's talking about here says this is Quran 434 it says this. MONA WALTER: I thought that if I tell them about about Muhammad and about Quran and this god of Islam who who hates who kill who discriminates women maybe they will have a choice and leave.

BRANDON:but in politically correct Sweden Mona Walter has come under attack for simply telling Muslims what is in the Quran

MONA WALTER: And I've been called islamophobe and yeah you you've been bought your house neighbor and stuff like that terrible things.

BRANDON: she has also been called a racist Walter warns that Islamic radicalism is a serious threat in Sweden and says Swedish Society should care more about women trapped in Islam they will think like oh we we're in Sweden we have freedom of religion but Muslim women don't have a freedom of religion they they live under the law of Allah not under a Swedish law so they will suppose everyone have a freedom of religion

MONA WALTER: We don't have - we don't have freedom of religion it's not for Muslim woman is for for everyone else.

BRANDON: she lives under death threats and sometimes travels with police protection she wanted to show us Muslim areas around Gothenburg but had to First dress as a Muslim she believes if she were to show her face she would be attacked.

MONA WALTER: I never go to those area just to being a me just to being in Flesh and Blood Mona I never get out of there life I mean Muslim are normally good people like like everyone else but when they when they read Quran then they become a killing machine this So-Cal Isis or alab or book Haram they're not like they're not extremist they're not fanatical or they're just a good Muslim good Muslim who follow teachings of Islam the prophet Muhammad he did that they doing just what he did.

BRANDON: Walter now uses videos and speaking appearances to spread her message and she he says she won't stop even though her life is in danger. [QURAN 4:34]

"Men are in charge of women by right of what Allah has given one over the other and what they spend for maintenance from their wealth so righteous women are devoutly obedient guarding in the husband's absence what Allah would have them guard but those wives from whom you fear arrogance first advise them then if they persist forsake them in bad and finally strike them or beat them but if they obbey you once more seek no means against them indeed Allah is ever exalted and Grand."

Now a common response to this is that the word hit there or beat there really means to hit lightly I actually had the chance when in the Middle East to ask this exact question to a Muslim Imam and he demonstrated the way he recommended that men punish their wives here was a small clip of that conversation:


"How can I strike her he say you bring this you know what we call this give me your hand I slap you with this don't do this mistakes okay this is the teaching of the Prophet Muhammad now you understand."

BRANDON: But I actually also came across a verse in sah Muslim book for Hadith 21:27 where Aisha reported quote:

"I have not seen any women suffering as much as believing women look her skin is greener than her clothes."

BRANDON: So here is here is Aisha who by the way was 6 years old when Muhammad married her 9 years old when he consummated that marriage with her which we could have a whole other video just on that but here's Aisha admitting that Muslim women are green with bruises so all I'm saying is please look at this topic yourself don't take my word for it this really is the tip of the iceberg Injustice anywhere is a threat to Justice everywhere and we're living in a truly strange and bizarre time where religious pluralism is this veneer of of acceptance and of love but that veneer is actually causing us it's it's causing people to supersede the rights of individuals and the rights of women with this idea of religious pluralism which I think is is a huge problem so lastly look at this graph from the UN women from UNICEF showing the extent to which the mistreatment of women has been accepted even by women in Muslim countries around the world. so as you're looking at this graph let me just say one more time that the aim

of this video is not to insult or disrespect or disparage any Muslim people any Muslim uh fellow human beings this is not an attack on people it's more so that as I come across information like this I think that we have a responsibility to



show that there are some very significant problems with some ideologies within Islam that these things have a real world impact so in other words because we're called to love people we have to expose things that are working against human rights and working against human flourishing so so I think that that's it for now for a video like this um obviously this is a heavy topic I'm sure some people might be offended so feel free to let me know your thoughts in the comment section I'm genuinely just wanting to shed light on what seems to be a very problematic doctrine that is also being practiced within Islam in the real world thanks for watching see you in the next one
