Who Is Hamas? Hamas free Palestine from the river to the sea. Intifada. All eyes on Rafa. Stop the starvation of the Palestinian people in Gaza. All eyes on Gaza city. Is Hamas a political party? Is it a freedom movement or is it a terrorist organization? Today we will explain all about this organization called Hamas and what it stands for.

I'm Pinto. Let's open the black box of an idea. Let's have coffee first. [Music] So most people watch this war through the clips and through the headlines. Very few people see the architecture behind it. Today, I'll walk you through why I believe that in Israel, in this Israel Hamas war, the Israelis are the good guys and Hamas are the bad guys. I know that that might sound very simple or even unpopular when the world sees heartbreaking images from Gaza, but it's still the truth and it's an easy truth to forget in the daily noise that we are hearing.

So guys, if you want the full picture without the fluff, stay with me and subscribe so that you never miss any update for me. [Music] Let's start with the moral line. Why good versus evil isn't a slogan. When I say Israel is The Birth Of Hamas the good guys, I'm not doing a propaganda.

Israel and the IDF are fighting a just war against a murderous terrorist organization. Israel's goals are ethical and life oriented. Our goal is simple, to live in peace with our neighbors. History shows it. Israelis do not want to conquer Gaza. We left Gaza by choice in 2005. We don't want to erase Gaza from the map. If Israel had wanted that with our fire power and our advantage in the military realm, it could have been done years ago.

Hamas, on the other hand, openly seeks to erase Israel and would gladly repeat October 7 attacks across the entire country. That's why the two sides are not the same. There is a massive moral asymmetry here and it matters. Let's strip away all the noise and what's left is ideology. Why shouldn't Hamas's action surprise anyone? Again, let's strip away all the noise and what would remain is ideology. Hamas is a Palestinian Islamic organization that began in the late 1980s during the first intifada popular uprising against Israel.

It grew out of the Muslim Brotherhood in Gaza, combining militant activity with social services like schools and charities. Over time, it became both a political movement and a military group. Its ideology is set out in the Hamas charter of 1988, which calls for the destruction of Israel and the creation of an Islamic state over all of historic Palestine. The charter frames the conflict as a religious duty and includes anti-semitic ideas and conspiracy theories.

For decades, Hamas has carried out suicide bombings, rocket attacks, and kidnappings. Because of this, many countries, including the United States and the European Union, have labeled it as

a terrorist organization. In 2007, it took over the Gaza Strip from Fatah and has ruled there since, regularly clashing with Israel while holding both political and military power. Fatah, by the way, is another Palestinian faction that controls the West Bank, Judaea Samaria area. Guys, that's why ceasefire crossings and blockades are a tactical tool when useful.

Hamas references the 1967 lines that call for a two-state option in Israel. When needed, it shifts back to extermination talk and from the river to the sea, which means the elimination of Jewish people from the river to the sea. All of Israel, the message is consistent. No recognition of Israel, no acceptance of Jewish sovereignty, and no real respect for civilian life. The rest buys time, money, and legitimacy. Look around the region and also online.

Lebanon, Gaza, Yemen. The same pattern, an eternal enemy, a conspiracy about Jews or the West. And one magic solution, perpetual struggle. This is not normal politics. It's a totalitarian movement in religious clothing. And the bottom line, national conflicts can be managed with borders and with interest. But with Messianic ideology, there is no symmetry. When one side sanctifies the killings of civilians as a victory, there aren't two narratives.

There is morality versus the rejection of morality. And here's one more point. If Gaza and welfare were the goal, money would go to infrastructure, to schools, to hospitals. Instead, the choice is terror tunnels, rockets, propaganda, and brainwashing the children. That's not mismanagement. It's values. Now, let's go to the narrative that this world actually invented a people's group.

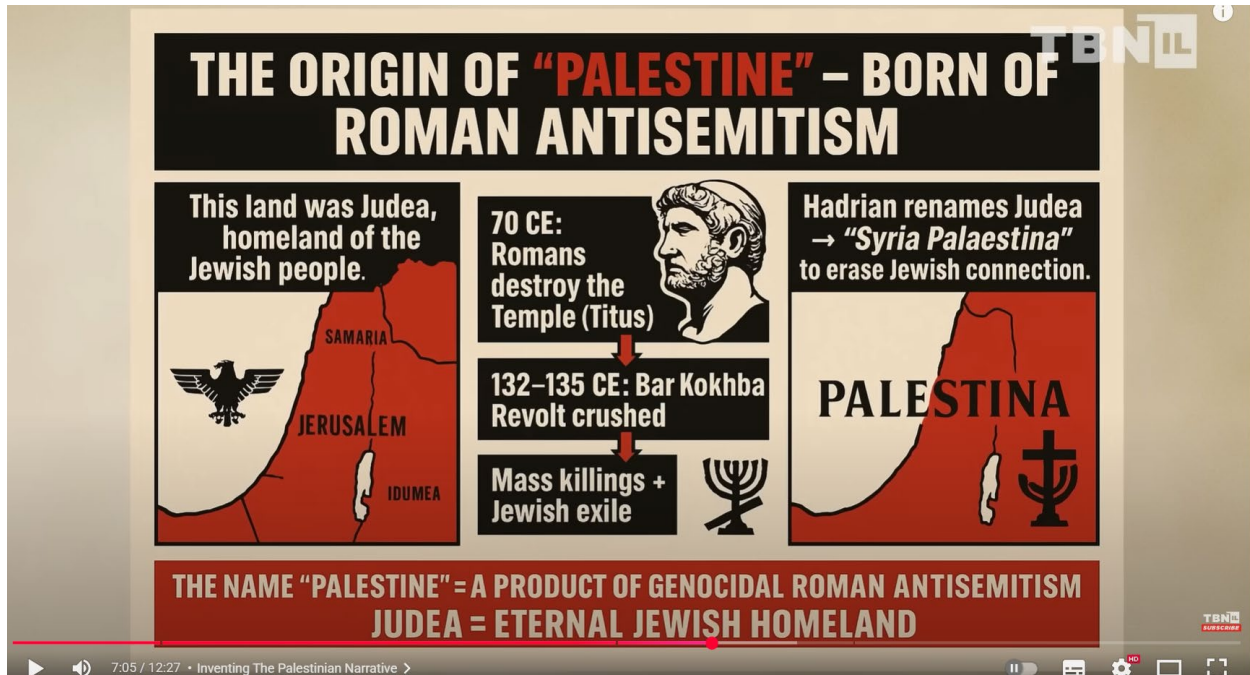

The Muslim Brotherhood is founded in Egypt with a core message, Islam is the solution. Law, education, and politics should all be religious. When persuasion fails, jihad is permitted. In the 1950s to the 1960s, Sahed Kutab hardens the doctrine. The world splits into believers versus ignorance, and Jews are cast as an essential enemy. This isn't criticism of Zionism. It is Jew hatred wrapped up in religious language. 1970s Gaza Sheikh Ahmed Yasim builds El Mujama El Islami the local brotherhood arm. It looks like welfare and schools but the real purpose is power mosques nos and influence cells. That was the quiet wall. Today it's rockets and tunnels. We must remember two key points when we are thinking about this issue. First one is that due hatred is at the heart of the system, not an add-on. Under pressure, the language softens when pressure eases. It snaps back to from the river to the sea. That isn't reform, it's a tactic. Second, politics is only a tool. In the 2006, Hamas won an election. In 2007, it staged a violent coup. Since then, so-called welfare has been a means of control, but not the goal of this organization. Peaceful Solutions, Initiatives and International Conferences:

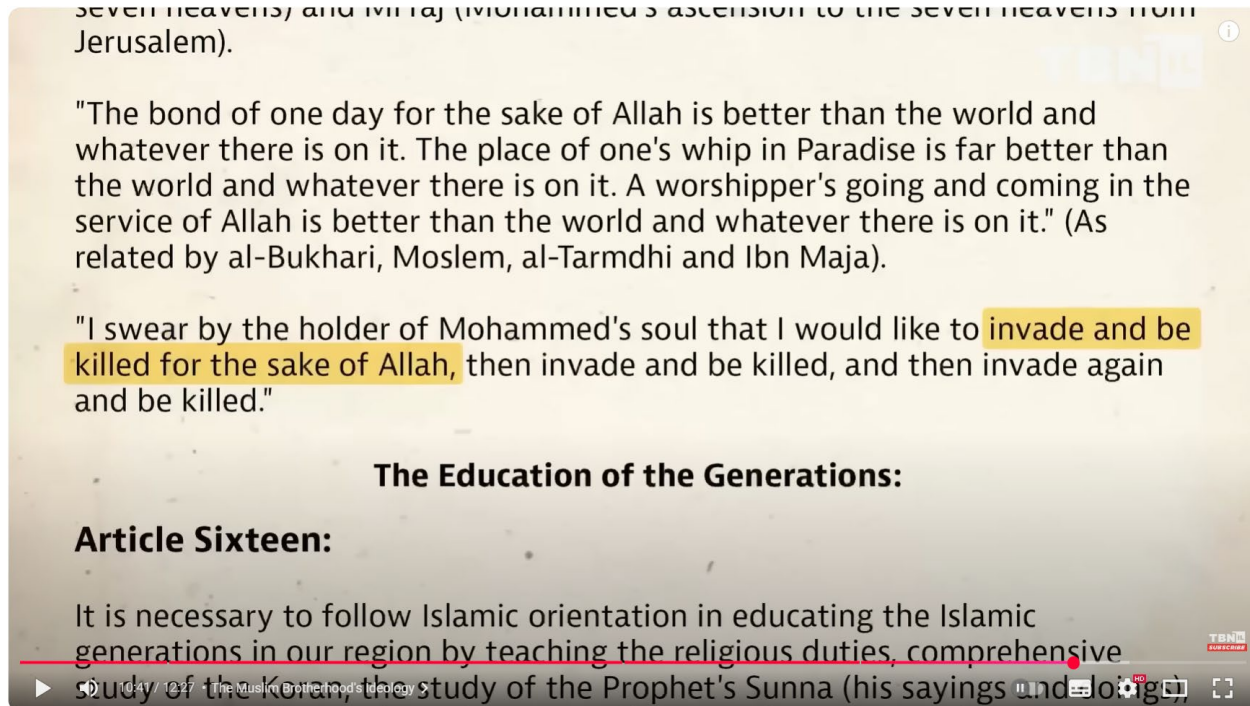
Article Thirteen:
