

Influence and current status

Historical influence:

Modern followers:

Today, Zoroastrianism is one of the world's smallest religions, with a global population estimated to be between 100,000 and 200,000. The largest community is found in India, where they are known as Parsis.

Gazelle: Hi everyone. Can you guys hear me over the noise? Okay. My name is Gazelle. I'm German American. I was born in Iran. I'm not Jewish. I'm not Christian. I'm not Israeli. So you might be wondering, what is she doing here? Is she just crushing our party? No, we share the same enemy and we share the same value for truth.

We are in fact ancient allies and the propaganda machine of the Islamists don't want you to know that they have spent billions of dollars over the years to convince you that Iran is a radical Islamist country with men in turbans screaming for jihad. Well, fun fact, these men in turbans are not Iranians.

There are Arab Islamists occupying Iran, killing Iranians. 90% of the Iranian population is against them. And even after half a century of indoctrination, barely 30% of Iranians identify as Muslim. Our ancient faith is *Zoroastrianism*. That's my faith. So no, we don't wear turbans. We don't scream for jihad. And we're not descendants of these Ayatollas.

We are descendants of Cyrus the Great. Thank you. You have heard of him before. In history, he's known for writing the first charter on human rights, including that freedom of faith is protected. He was also a supporter of Zionism. Yeah, Zionism is not something new. It's as old as time, thousands of years ago, when the Babylonians tried to ethnically cleanse the Jews out of their homeland and destroyed their temples, cast them out, and held them as slaves.

Cyrus the Great, an Iranian, freed the Jews from slavery, returned them to their homeland, rebuilt their temple. That is the Iran these ayat don't want you to know still exists today, ready to be by your side. And if this story is new to you, this is the story of the entire Middle East.

And when they couldn't break him, they killed him last October. For almost a year now, we're trying to get his mutilated body back to America. And I hope our administration will finally help us to bring him here, lay him to rest in peace and power.
