Sharia law support in Britain isn't a "fringe" position anymore. It's not an exaggeration. It's not fear-mongering. It's math. A new poll shows one-third of British Muslims openly saying Sharia in the UK would be "desirable." And this isn't an isolated finding. Surveys going back nearly 20 years show the exact same trend:

- 40% wanted Sharia in Muslim-majority areas (2006)
- 37% of young Muslims preferred Sharia over British law (2007)
- 23% supported Sharia in some UK areas (2016)
- 32% want Sharia nationwide (Henry Jackson Society, 2024)
- 33% of young Muslims say Sharia would be desirable (UnHerd, 2023)

This isn't "diversity."

This is a parallel value system growing inside the West.

And I'm joined by Nuriyah Khan, who fled Sharia, survived abuse justified by religious law, and now exposes the ideology from the inside. She explains exactly why these polls matter and why Western societies keep ignoring the warning signs.

UK. For UK for UK for UK for UK. All right, folks. This is Harris Sultan. The video that I just played at the start, you have seen me play it to you many times before. And a lot of people say, "Well, Harris, you're stoking unnecessary fears. That's just an aberration. and these people do not make up the majority of the Muslim population living in western countries blah blah blah. But the question is how many of those Muslims exist in Britain or France or Germany or now in the United States? What percentage of the Muslim population harbors these kind of views or even aspirations?

Talk TV just did a program on this question and they invited our very own Nura Khan to comment on this survey. So let me read that to you. A new poll has found that a third of British Muslims think it would be desirable to implement Sharia law. A third of British Muslims that is roughly around 33%. Okay, 33%. Now where are they actually getting this number from? I actually covered this survey. This survey is not that new. It's from 2024. A survey by the Henry Jackson Society found that 32% of British Muslims wanted Sharia law implemented in Britain.

Separately, another survey by Unheard, which is not a right-wing think tank. It's a very academic organization, found that 33% of young British Muslims believed that implementing Sharia law

would be desirable. And this is in line with many other surveys that have been done over the decades across varying Muslim populations. So a 2006 poll by the Sunday Telegraph found that 40% of British Muslims wanted Sharia law introduced in predominantly Muslim areas. Oh, sorry. Why am I not showing you the actual screen that I'm looking at? This is what I've been reading it from.

So a 2006 poll by the Sunday Telegraph found that 40% of British Muslims wanted Sharia law introduced in predominantly Muslim areas. So that's what they mean by those no-go zones creating their own enclaves, creating their own mini little Pakistan everywhere. These patrols have been going on for years and a CNN report caught Muslims from patrol in London harassing residents. In White Chapel, one man can be heard insulting a gay man, calling him offensive names and telling him he wasn't welcome in a Muslim area.

Others denounced residents for drinking, claiming this is a Muslim area and alcohol is not permitted. They also harassed a woman as she was crossing the street, warning her that her short skirt was not allowed in Muslim areas. And now with the arrival of these Muslim patrols to New York City, Americans are becoming worried they'll fall under the same harassment for not following Islamic practices.

A 2007 survey and other survey found that 37% of young Muslims and 16 and 24 preferred Sharia law over British law compared to just 17% of those over 55. And then a 2016 Channel 4 poll of British Muslims reported that nearly a quarter 23% supported introducing Sharia law in some areas of the UK.

From that survey of Henry Jackson Society, I have some other numbers as well. So while 34% of British Muslims said that it would be desirable to have Sharia in Britain, only 23% said that it would be undesirable. So basically we have more Muslims wanting Sharia than those who don't want Sharia. Yes, of course there are some other people in between. I think that makes up about 50%. What do I always say about these non-aligned Muslims, these average lipstick Muslims? They don't know what's going on. They will join the winning side.

They are irrelevant in this. They are those Germans who saw Nazi take over Germany. They were irrelevant. But when push comes to shove, just like every one of us, they will also have a price to pay. So what's the key takeaway from this? More Muslims, i.e. 34% want Sharia in Britain and less Muslims, only 23% do not want Sharia in Britain. What does that tell you about the threat of Islamization of Britain?

Another question, 57% said that compulsory use of halal food in all schools and hospital. What's more, 57% of the respondents also said that there should be compulsory use of halal food in all schools and hospitals. So you as a non-Muslim would be forced to eat halal food. something that you as a humanist, someone who loves animals, most westerners love animals, you have to

take part in the cruel and barbaric practice of halal food. Make Eid, not the one in which they slaughter animals. 67% of British Muslims said that make Eid fat a public holiday like Christmas.

Mind you, Muslims only make up 8% of the British population. Just 8%, not even 10. Look what they want when they are at 8%. The only reason why none of this has happened yet is because they are 8%. What do you think will happen when they're 15% or 20%. Multiculturalism has failed. It doesn't work. There should be a Muslim political party that should look after Muslim interests. Only 16% of British Muslims said that it would be undesirable. It implies that 84% said, "Yeah, you know what? Yeah, why not? We should have a Muslim political party that should put Muslim interests at the forefront.

This is the reason why you see there is a unanimous support for any Muslim politician who says free Palestine. They stick to their own tribe. They don't care about any other issues. They don't care about the cost of living crisis or Britain is going down. Pensioners are sleeping rough. Veterans are struggling. They don't care about any other issue.

They don't care because again this is a culture that looks after its own. Can you blame them? I don't know. I I don't want to go into that. I just want to make a case for you to understand that multiculturalism has failed. Multiculturalism does not work.

The only time it works is when a person has fully let go of his previous culture and has integrated into the main dominant culture. In which case it hasn't worked because I am not a multiculturalist. I live my life like a western man. I don't I don't do anything that's Pakistani or Islamic or Muslimish. I just don't do it. I'm not picking on them. Not saying that those who want to do it, it's wrong for them to do it.

I'm just saying that cultures don't mix because these cultures have been fighting each other for thousands of years. And you think that they're going to let go of their grievances within a generation and say, "Whoa, that's okay. This is the reason why blacks are demanding reparations. Indians are demanding reparations for colonialism. Muslims are demanding Sharia in Britain. All of these cultures, they're looking out for their own.

And the white culture or western culture was the first culture to let everyone in, embrace everyone on the basis of equality. They're the ones being told to, you know, pay reparations or apologize or give up their own cultural practices or their own values. Something is clearly broken here. So let me show you what is Nuya Khan saying about this because this is obviously a very critical point.

Nuriyah Khan: Personally I had to flee from Sharia law myself when I was kind of dealt with the full um brutality of it when it comes to a woman pursuing divorce because within Sharia law that right is unilaterally given to a man under strict Islamic law.

Sultan: Um, those of you who don't know who Nury Khan is, Nurya Khan is an ex-Muslim activist. I was the first person to interview her about her story. So, if you look it up, this is Nury Khan's story. Why Nury Khan left Islam. I interviewed her nearly four years ago. Check out her story. Very interesting, very compelling story. It will tell you why Muslims become ex-Muslims. And please don't judge my interview skills, okay? Apparently, I'm a horrible interviewer. I interrupt a lot. I guess I just interrupted you again. Anyway, let's get back to what Nahan is saying.

Nuriyah Khan: And so, you have to fight tooth and nail, if that, to um even be granted one, and it got to the point in my personal case where it just got too dangerous because there's so many other punishments that they can use against you.

Um, first and foremost is disobedience towards your husband and that's what they charged me with. um which was essentially about to like use a Sharia law to kidnap me and send me back to an abusive husband whereby I can't leave the house without his permission. And that comes directly from a verse in the Quran itself.

And that is how they treat Muslim women out there because you have no choice to enact any other law. Even if you've got a different nationality or you come from somewhere else, you have to use Sharia if you're a Muslim.

Sultan: This is why it makes it all the more annoying when you see these woke feminist western liberal women get in bed with the ideology of Islam. These woke women would not last a day under Sharia. Yet they cover for these Islamists. Terrible.

TV Host: All you need to do, right, is usher divorce, divorce, divorce three times from the male side in order to enact a divorce under Sharia. Correct.

Nuriyah Khan: Yeah, absolutely. the male just has to pronounce that word three times on three separate occasions. And it's got to the point now in countries like the UAE and I believe Saudi Arabia as well where you can a man can literally just text that to his wife and be like don't come home.

Sultan: Just I hadn't watched this video before. I guess the point is this is what those British Muslims this is what those 34% of British Muslims asking for and every person who doesn't call them out is also indirectly endorsing this including those woke blue-haired western liberal women. They're their own worst enemy.

TV Host: Cheeky WhatsApp. Three divorces and it's all good.

Nuriyah Khan: Yeah, absolutely. I think the um Imran Khan when he was prime minister of Pakistan did that to his wife.

TV Host: Was it Did he do it to Jamaima? Poor Jamaima.

Nuriyah Khan: No, he did it. He did it to another British Pakistani.

TV Host: Yeah, Jamaima wouldn't put up with that.

Nuriyah Khan: Not yet.

TV Host: But no, you're right. Uh it's been used time and time again.

Sultan: And and I Khan used to be a bit more westernized back then, though. So he wouldn't have done it to Jamaima, by the way, just to, you know, be a devil's advocate.

TV Host: issue with Sharia law is that because it's such an extreme uh version of Islam, you know, there are things like within this study when asked about how desirable it was for homosexuality to be outlawed, 17% said it was very desirable and 10% said it was somewhat desirable.

Sultan: Again, you have more Muslims defending Sharia or wanting Sharia than those not wanting it. So I guess the challenge is what to do about those Muslims even though their number is smaller as I said 34% want Sharia in Britain but there are 23% who don't want Sharia which is a big deal for a Muslim to say because every Muslim no matter how liberal you are you are raised with the idea that Allah is the one true creator of the universe and his word we have to respect it his word is above everything else above man-made laws like British law, like western laws or Pakistani laws or whatnot, you have to put shar above everything. Even if you don't believe in it, you have to say it.

So that's why it's a big deal for these 23% Muslims to say, "No, we don't want sh." So what do we do about them? How do we protect those liberal Muslims, albeit they are far fewer in number? So I guess it's easier to absorb them because the number is smaller and they're not the biggest reason for this mess of failing multiculturalism. So Reform Party's candidate Mayuran Senthilnathan, he actually articulated it really well. Have a listen to this. I never heard this before. I never thought about it like this. This is very good.

TV Host: Problem for sure for us to tackle over here in Britain. There is a real chasm and a lack of community cohesion with some of these uh communities that do totally fence themselves off a little bit more. And you know what I mean? I I don't want us to say, "Oh, let's

all hold hands and kumbaya." But I do wish that British values were the center of all this, not oh let's embrace this, let's embrace that. Would you would you agree with that, Niah?

Nuriyah Khan: Yeah, absolutely. But you have to remember one um really important factor here is that Islam has this element of supremacy built into it. So when you're comparing divine law to man-made law, which in their eyes that is British law, uh Sharia wins every single time, hands down. So if you ask somebody on a personal level as well, if they are a devout practicing Muslim, which law do they believe is more just and more equitable and that they would, you know, sooner follow, it would usually be Sharia,

Sultan: which is why I said 23% of Muslims saying that it's undesirable to have Sharia. They need our protection. They need some support from us. I think it's good that these topics are now being discussed openly on mainstream media. and ex-Muslims are being asked for their input on this because we've been shouting from the rooftops about this danger, but nobody paid any attention.

But I always knew it was always going to happen. Just like as I've always believed that this unholy alliance between the left and Islam is going to fall apart at some point. Right now, they're united because they're both anarchists. They both want to destroy the status quo, which is Western civilization, Western world order, the organized world order, our secular liberal parliamentary democracy. They want to bring that down and they want to replace it with their own worldview.

So that's why they see each other as allies, but they are not allies. They are diametrically opposed to each other, which is the reason why your party - your party, which was the most farleft political party in Britain, they're falling apart.
